



ARMRY SHAKEDOWN

LISTING AND USER CONTENT POLICY

Effective Date: [July, 4th, 2026]

This Listing and User Content Policy (this "**Policy**") sets out your rights and responsibilities when listing Items for sale on the Armry Shakedown online marketplace (the "**Service**"). By creating an account on Armry Shakedown, and again at each Listing on the Service, you agree to be bound by this Policy. This Policy is a legally binding agreement between you and ARMRY SHAKEDOWN L.L.C., a Michigan limited liability company ("**Armry Shakedown**," the "**Platform**," "**we**," "**us**," or "**our**"). If you do not agree to this Policy, you may not use or access the Service.

This Policy is incorporated by reference into, and forms a part of, the Armry Shakedown Terms of Service (the "**Terms**"). In the event of any conflict between this Policy and the Terms, this Policy governs. Capitalized terms not defined in this Policy have the meanings assigned to them in the Terms.

We may amend this Policy at any time by posting a revised version on the Service. Your continued use of the Service after the effective date of any amendment constitutes your acceptance of the revised Policy. You may not use or access or continue to use or access the Service if you do not agree to the revised Policy.

SECTION 1 LISTINGS

1.1 Requirements.

All Listings must include: (a) an accurate and complete description of the Item, including its condition, brand, model, and any known defects; (b) clear photographs of the actual Item being sold; (c) an accurate price in United States Dollars; and (d) accurate shipping terms.

1.2 Seller Certification.

By posting a Listing, the Seller affirmatively represents, warrants, and certifies that: (a) the Seller has clear title to and the legal right to sell the Item; (b) the Item is not stolen, misappropriated, or subject to any lien or encumbrance; (c) the Item is accurately described in the Listing; (d) the sale and shipment of the Item complies with the Terms and all applicable federal, state, and local laws; (e) the Item is not a Prohibited Item; and (f) for any Restricted Item, the Listing accurately states the magazine's round capacity and the Seller has independently verified that the sale and shipment comply with all applicable capacity restrictions.

1.3 Expiration.

Each Listing will expire 30 calendar days from the date of publication. Upon expiration, the Listing will be removed from search results and will not be available for purchase. Sellers may re-list Items subject to the Terms.

SECTION 2 USER CONTENT

2.1 User Content.

By posting a Listing or any other content on the Service (“**User Content**”), you grant Armry Shakedown a nonexclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, transferable, sublicensable, perpetual, and irrevocable license to use, reproduce, modify, display, and distribute such User Content in connection with operating, promoting, and marketing the Service across any medium. This license survives termination of your Account.

2.2 Sole Responsibility.

You are solely responsible for all User Content you create, upload, post, or otherwise make available through the Service. Armry Shakedown does not endorse, verify, or assume any responsibility for User Content.

2.3 Prohibited User Conduct.

In connection with the Service, you agree not to: (a) infringe or violate any third party’s intellectual property rights, privacy rights, or other legal rights; (b) post any User Content that is false, misleading, defamatory, obscene, threatening, or harassing; (c) circumvent the Service by taking transactions off-platform in order to avoid payment of commissions or fees; (d) use the Service or User information for any unauthorized purpose, including unsolicited advertising or “spam”; (e) use any robot, spider, scraper, or other automated means to access the Service, or engage in data mining or extraction; (f) interfere with or disrupt the integrity, security, or performance of the Service or its underlying infrastructure; (g) attempt to access any area of the Service that you are not authorized to access; (h) create a false identity, impersonate another person, or misrepresent your affiliation with any person or entity; or (i) facilitate or encourage any violation of these Terms.

2.4 DMCA Compliance.

- (a) Armry Shakedown respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects Users to do the same. It is the Policy of Armry Shakedown to respond to notices of alleged copyright infringement that comply with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. § 512 (the “**DMCA**”). Armry Shakedown will, in appropriate circumstances, terminate the Accounts of Users who are repeat infringers of copyrighted works.
- (b) If you believe that your copyrighted work has been copied and is accessible on the Service in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, you may notify Armry Shakedown's designated copyright agent. Your notice must include: (i) a physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner; (ii) identification of the copyrighted work

claimed to have been infringed, or, if multiple works are covered by a single notification, a representative list of such works; (iii) identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing and that is to be removed, and information reasonably sufficient to permit Armry Shakedown to locate the material (such as the URL of the Listing); (iv) information reasonably sufficient to permit Armry Shakedown to contact you, such as your name, address, telephone number, and email address; (v) a statement that you have a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law; and (vi) a statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright that is allegedly infringed.

- (c) If you believe that User Content you posted was removed or disabled as a result of mistake or misidentification, you may submit a counter-notification to Armry Shakedown's designated copyright agent. Your counter-notification must include: (i) your physical or electronic signature; (ii) identification of the material that has been removed or to which access has been disabled and the location at which the material appeared before it was removed or disabled; (iii) a statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that the material was removed or disabled as a result of mistake or misidentification; and (iv) your name, address, and telephone number, and a statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of the federal district court for the judicial district in which your address is located (or, if your address is outside the United States, for Oakland County, Michigan), and that you will accept service of process from the person who provided notification of the alleged infringement. Upon receipt of a valid counter-notification, Armry Shakedown will forward it to the complaining party and will restore the removed material within ten to fourteen business days unless the complaining party notifies Armry Shakedown that it has filed a court action to restrain the allegedly infringing activity.
